

# Jonah — Worksheet 2: Answer Key

Nineveh Repents & Jonah's Anger — marking guide

Use this to mark your own worksheet. For reflection questions, there is no single right answer — check that your response genuinely engages with the passage.

## 1. What message does Jonah finally deliver to Nineveh, according to Jonah 3:4?

That in forty days, Nineveh would be overthrown.

## 2. How did the people of Nineveh respond (Jonah 3:5-9, summarise)?

They believed God, proclaimed a fast, and even the king put on sackcloth, hoping God might relent.

## 3. What did God do once He saw their repentance, according to Jonah 3:10?

He relented of the disaster He had said He would bring, and did not destroy them.

## 4. How did Jonah react to Nineveh being spared (Jonah 4:1-3)?

He was greatly displeased and angry, even asking God to take his life, because he had wanted Nineveh judged, not spared.

## 5. Reflection: Jonah struggled to want mercy for people he considered enemies. Is there a person or group you find it hard to want good things for?
