

# Matthew — Worksheet 2: Answer Key

The Death and Resurrection of Jesus — marking guide

Use this to mark your own worksheet. For reflection questions, there is no single right answer — check that your response genuinely engages with the passage.

## 1. What did Jesus do with the bread and the cup at the Last Supper, and what did He say they represented (Matthew 26:26-28)?

He broke the bread and called it His body, and gave the cup calling it His blood of the covenant, shed for many for the forgiveness of sins.

## 2. What did Jesus pray in the Garden of Gethsemane (Matthew 26:39)?

That the cup might pass from Him, yet not as He willed, but as the Father willed.

## 3. What happened at the moment Jesus died (Matthew 27:50-51)?

He cried out and gave up His spirit, and the veil of the Temple was torn in two from top to bottom, and the earth shook.

## 4. Who were the first to discover the empty tomb, and what did the angel tell them (Matthew 28:1-7)?

Mary Magdalene and 'the other Mary'; the angel told them Jesus was not there, for He had risen, as He said.

## 5. What instruction, known as the Great Commission, does Jesus give His disciples at the end of the book (Matthew 28:18-20)?

To go and make disciples of all nations, baptising them and teaching them to obey everything He commanded.

## 6. Reflection: Why do you think the resurrection is described as the central event of the Christian faith?

Open reflection — look for engagement with themes of victory over death, hope, and vindication of Jesus' claims.
