Ruth & Boaz — marking guide

Use this to mark your own worksheet. For reflection questions, there is no single right answer — check that your response genuinely engages with the passage.

**1. What was Ruth doing in Boaz's field when he first noticed her (Ruth 2:2-7, summarise)?**

Gleaning leftover grain to provide food for herself and Naomi.

**2. How does Boaz treat Ruth, a foreigner, in Ruth 2:8-12?**

With kindness and protection, instructing his workers to let her glean freely and even leave extra grain for her.

**3. What does Boaz say he has heard about Ruth (Ruth 2:11)?**

How she left her homeland to care for Naomi.

**4. What happens between Ruth and Boaz by the end of the book (Ruth 4:13)?**

Boaz marries Ruth, and they have a son.

**5. Who is named as Ruth's great-grandson later in Israel's history (Ruth 4:17)?**

David.

**6. Reflection: Ruth's story moves from tragedy to restoration. Where in your own life are you hoping to see that same kind of turnaround?**

Open, personal reflection.
